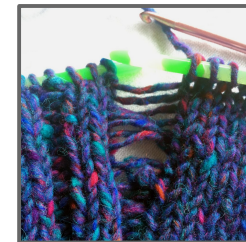
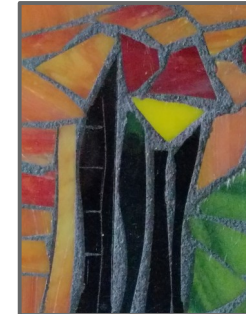

Knit Fix!

With Knitting Instructor, Lisa Beams

Do you rip out stitching after making a mistake, or let it sit in a basket hoping for someone else to fix it? Lisa will help you learn how to “read” your knitting, recognize knitting mishaps, and learn how to prevent and, in many cases, repair them without unraveling rows of work.

Prerequisite: Basic knitting skills (call if uncertain)

Please bring: a skein of light-color, medium-weight yarn, a set of knitting needles in size US7 or 8, and a size E or medium crochet hook. We'll practice making, then fixing, mistakes!

Optional: “That one project” sitting at the bottom of the basket because a mistake left you feeling stuck. Lisa will host a one-hour Q&A time after class to help anyone with questions.

Weave a Market Basket

With Instructors, Linda Cleveland & Jenny Myers

Learn classic basket-making skills while weaving your own hand-made harvest basket. Each basket has a woven 8"x10" base, a 4"-5" side and incorporates a “D” handle. Students will learn a continuous weave technique and how to lash a flat oval rim.

Prerequisite: No experience necessary

Bring: Students should bring an old towel and wear clothing that can get messy and wet.
