

- Prune roses if that hasn't already been done. Most rose specialista prefer February pruning.Fertilize fruit trees.
- Prune dormant grapes.

• Prepare the spring garden for planting by spading the ground at least two weeks before planting.

Put raked leaves and grass cuttings in a compost pile.

February is the month to apply pre-emergence herbicides to control weeds such as sandspurs and goose grass.

Vegetables to plant: beets, broccoli, cabbage, carrots, cauliflower, celery, collards, endive/escarole, lettuce, mustard, bunching onions, English peas, potatoes, radishes and turnips.

• Annuals to plant: baby's breath, calendulas, carnations, dusty miller, pansies, petunias, Marguerite dasies, snapdragons, dianthus and statice.

## News from Around the Shores St. Augustine Shores Service Corporation's Board of Directors January Meeting

The St. Augustine Shores Service Corporation's Board of Directors held their monthly meeting January 8, 2015 and conducted the following business.

The Minutes of December 11, 2014 were accepted.

The Treasurer's Report was accepted with explanation of several large expenditures.

Attorney Jeremiah Mulligan, of Rumrell, Mcleod and Brock, P.A. gave a favorable status report on recovery of collections for accounts handled by their Firm.

Mulligan reported on staff changes and changes in accounting procedures. Improvements are having a positive effect on the collection effort.

The Board discussed progress of the pool marcite project which is scheduled to complete the end of January.

Three bids were received for the pool bathhouse renovation, which were opened at a special meeting on January 15, 2015. The Board awarded the bathhouse renovation project to JTN Construction. Permitting and work are starting with the goal of having essentially new bathhouses by early April.

Important dates prior to the May Annual Meeting were discussed with the critical need for candidates interested in running for Board of Directors making application by February 15, 2015.

Representatives of Homes by Deltona presented their request for a major modification to the PUD affecting Unit The current St. Augustine Shores PUD has a front yard setback of 25 feet and Homes by Deltona has submitted a Major Modification to the PUD, asking for a variance on 16 lots to reduce the front yard setback from 25 feet to 20 feet. This variance is only for a total of 16 lots along Belen Lane and Venecia Way that are adjacent to a preserved wetland and does not include the entire San Sevino neighborhood. The next step in the PUD modification process is a hearing before the County Commission February 17, 2015 at 1:30 p.m. in the County Administration Building.




