EXCLUSION POLICY

Control of communicable disease should be all parties primary concern.

Policies and guidelines related to outbreaks of communicable diseases and illnesses in this daycare have been developed with the help of the local health department and local pediatricians in order to protect the group as a whole as well as the health of your own child. I ask that parents assist us by keeping sick children at home. If they have or have experienced any of the following symptoms in the past 24 hours they must be kept at home. In some circumstances a medical note may be required in order to return to daycare.

- \blacktriangleright A fever of 100° orally or 99° under the arm
- Signs of newly developed cough or severe cough
- > Diarrhea, vomiting, or an upset stomach
- > Unusual or unexplained loss of appetite, fatigue, irritability, or headache
- > Any discharge or drainage from the eyes, nose, ears, or open sores
- Unexplained rashes

Children who show signs or symptoms listed above will be sent home ASAP. We appreciate your cooperation with this policy, as it is to protect the health of the entire group.

If you have any questions concerning this policy and whether your child should not attend, please call us before bringing your child to the daycare.
