State News Updates

April 3, 2020

- Governor Cuomo held a press conference at 11:00 AM and provided the following information:
 - Total positive cases 102,863:
 - 14,810 Hospitalizations.
 - 3,731 ICU patients.
 - 8,886 discharges.
 - Total deaths 2,935 up from 2,373.
 - Supplies:

0

- Need companies to make masks, gowns, face shields, and other PPE.
- Javits will be a COVID-19 only facility.
- Ventilators:
 - New York does not have enough, and is still utilizing the same methods to try to increase the supply; including trying to buy from China.
 - The Governor will be signing an Executive Order allowing the State to take ventilators and PPE from hospitals which will be returned or reimbursed.
 - National Guard will be utilized to redistribute the ventilators.
- Provided an overview of the Enacted Budget.
- 20,000 people from outside of New York State have volunteered to help.
 - When New York's curve is over, the Governor has pledged we will return the favor.
 - Launched a <u>new website</u> to provide COVID-19 testing data to the public.
- New drive-through testing facility will open in Albany next week, and seven have been opened to date.
