Relative to extending the heartfelt condolences of *I Mina'Bente Sais na Liheslaturan Guåhan* to the family of the late Richard P. Kautz, and memorializing his outstanding contributions to the people of Guam.

BE IT RESOLVED BY I LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:

WHEREAS, the late Richard P. Kautz, Founder of Kautz and Sons Glass Company, Incorporated, born on January 7, 1932 in Saginaw, Michigan, passed away on Friday, January 26, 2001, at the age of sixty-nine (69); and

WHEREAS, the late Richard P. Kautz is survived by his wife, Claire A. Kautz, their four (4) sons, Richard, David, Thomas, and Peter, and their eight (8) grandchildren; and

WHEREAS, the late Richard P. Kautz, a resident of Mangilao, was supportive throughout his life to the Aloha Council, Boy Scouts of America, especially Troop 2 in Tamuning, giving generously to their annual scouting events; and

WHEREAS, the late Richard P. Kautz, a devout Catholic, supported the Catholic Church through the annual Catholic Charities Appeal and assisted the Island's Churches with the design and manufacture of windows and doors during Church construction and renovation projects; and

WHEREAS, the late Richard P. Kautz will also be remembered for his generosity to the *manamko* who he aided by replacing their broken glass windows; and

WHEREAS, the late Richard P. Kautz was a strong supporter of sporting activities and helped in sponsoring the Mobil Games, the Guam Special Olympics, local motor cross races, and a number of village Little League baseball teams; and

WHEREAS, the late Richard P. Kautz was recognized by the Small Business Administration (SBA) as the "SBA Small Business Person of the Year" in 1994. In 1995, the late Richard P. Kautz was honored by the Glazers Union of Hawaii when he received his "Gold Card" and was given lifetime membership after being a member of the Union for forty (40) years; and

WHEREAS, Kautz and Sons Glass Company, Incorporated was the first local window manufacturing company to incorporate a typhoon resistant design into their window manufacturing process. The late Richard P. Kautz was recognized by Governor Ricardo J. Bordallo for his efforts to train the Island's workforce in the skill of glazing; now therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that *I Mina'Bente Sais Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of the people of Guam, extend its heartfelt condolences to the family of the late Richard P. Kautz and memorialize his outstanding contributions to the people of Guam; and be it further
