Thank you to the 30 members who have donated face masks for Riverside Hospital. We have donated about 1,500 face masks so far. The need still exists for face masks for Riverside outpatients and visitors to the hospital. We will continue to collect face masks through July and deliver them to Riverside. If you have contributed to other hospitals groups, that is good since the need for face masks is great. Every face mask helps, but I want to recognize some members for contributing a large number of face masks.



Kitty Tully donated 217. Marilyn River is over 200 and still making them daily. Vicki Marsh donated 173. Mark and Cathy Fowler donated 106. Denise Vassar donated 101. Yvette Cienski and Norma Sims each donated 75. Donating over 50 are Heidi Borchardt, Linda Tozier, Sweetie Davis, Joan Kelly and Jeanne Surber. On Tuesday June 16, I delivered the last nine dozen headbands with buttons sewn on them to Riverside. We were given 222 dozen or 2,664 headbands and buttons. We were asked to sew two buttons on



each headband. The headbands are for their nurses and staff members. The strings of face masks can be put around the buttons instead of around the ears. Thirty seven of our Guild members sewed buttons on at least three dozen headbands. Seven of our members sewed at least 11 dozen headbands. Several of our members used their own buttons when the buttons were in short supply.



Hartman did four dozen and helped with headband deliveries and pick ups. Carol Pittman did five dozen. The members that did six dozen headbands were Jeanne Surber, Marge Edwards, Margie Layser, Connie Bond, Nancy Shrout, Anne Shultz, Carol Nourse, Shonda Berry, Carol Richardson and Wanda Fralick, a returning member. Donna Albright, Marilyn Rivera and Trina Murray did eleven dozen each. Diane Ziemet and Lois Bates with the help of her neighbor did twelve dozen. Amy Mazich did thirteen dozen.

Sandy O'Brien did 17 dozen headbands using mostly her own buttons. Sandy, also, made 72 crochet extenders with buttons for the Hospice and Home Health nurses at Riverside. She seems to have an unending button stash. As you can see it took a lot of members to complete this project. Carolyn Smith, Volunteer Services Coordinator, Lena Anderson with RHS Supply Chain Management and Allison Fonner with the Riverside Foundation were very impressed and appreciative of the Guild helping them during the COVID 19 crisis. Thank you to everyone that helped with this Headband Project for Riverside Hospital.
