PUMC INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY

Workweek

- If the AA Public Schools are closed for the day due to weather, the office and building are closed for the entire day (no afternoon or evening activities unless otherwise notified or posted on the website, see "Evenings" below).
- If the AA Public Schools close early due to weather, the office and building close for the rest of the day (no afternoon or evening activities).
- If the AA Public Schools are open, but after-school and evening activities are canceled, the buildings and all activities after 4:00 p.m. are canceled.
- If any of the above occurs, **outside groups** (those not related to the ministry of PUMC, but just using our building) **are NOT to meet**.
- If the AA Public Schools are closed, PELC will be closed.
- If the AA Public Schools are delayed or close early, PELC will be delayed or will close early. Please check the PELC website for further info:
