

Canine Atopic Dermatitis Clinical Trial

Seeking your referrals of dogs with confirmed atopic dermatitis:

At least 12 months of age, weighing ≥ 3.0 kg and generally healthy.

At least moderate pruritus as assessed by the owner (a pruritus VAS score ≥ 6.0 units on a 10-unit scale).

Skin lesions typical of atopic dermatitis, (CADESI score ≥ 25).

No evidence of fleas, demodicosis, malignant neoplasia, or immune suppression such as hyperadrenocorticism.

Dear Dr. Referring Veterinarians,

Dermatology for Animals, Gilbert, Arizona is participating in a clinical trial for a new, once-daily investigational medical therapy to be used for the treatment of atopic dermatitis in dogs. The study is sponsored by a well-recognized animal health company, which will use the data collected as part of an animal drug approval application to the US Food and Drug Administration. Potential candidates are needed for this study, and we ask for your assistance in terms of referral of cases to our clinic. Potential cases must meet specific eligibility requirements, including some restrictions on recent medications and therapies.

Benefits of study participation include:

- If determined to be eligible, the dog will receive study-related physical examinations, skin assessments, laboratory analyses, & study treatment at no cost to the owner.
- After study completion, a client account credit will be sent to your hospital for the pet's continued veterinary care.
