A TRAIL OF DISCOVERY THROUGH THE SHEFFIELD TOUR



Let's explore Sheffield!

Like many cities in 21st century England, Sheffield is a sometimes confusing, and even confused metropolis. The evidence of the industrial past is everywhere, yet the affluent and bustling activities of modern, cosmopolitan life are also evident. This is a vibrant city in which to live, with a strong student community. Sadly, signs of poverty and homelessness are evident too.

Our trip starts at *Kelham Island*, the oldest part of industrial Sheffield. With atmospheric streets, the *Kelham Island Museum* and a plethora of great local pubs serving local craft beers, it is an area worthy of exploring and recently crowned the UK's best neighbourhood. Many of the old cutlery works are now home to trendy student apartments and bars.

Enroute to town pass the incredible building of the **National Emergency Services Museum**. Well worth checking out opening hours to see this one-of-a-kind collection. If you get a chance pop down to *Victoria Quays* - part of the 8 mile *Weirs* and *Tinsley Canal* walk and a tranquil rest from the bustle of the main city.



The city centre hosts a wonderful Town Hall building with impressive *Peace Gardens* as well as the newly developed *Winter Gardens* - a vast temperate glasshouse that neighbours the city's *Millennium galleries*.

A wonderful panoramic 'city scape' can be viewed from the amphitheatre above the main train station.

To the south of the city along London Road is Abbeydale Road - and the area known as The Sheffield Antiques Quarter. Check the various business entries here in The Antiques **Tourist** before you commit to a particular route, as opening times vary. The Sheffield Antiques Quarter is an interesting social/ commercial enterprise which has attempted to bring similar trading businesses together, in an otherwise neglected part of the city. Bargain hunters will be well aware of the opportunities to be had in such areas. Try Swifty's and T.H. Goode, both architectural/salvage dealers on Abbeydale Road. And Dronfield Antiques a lovely traditional antiques shop, spread across 10 rooms also on Abbeydale Road.

A visit to Abbeydale Road is not complete without seeing the 1920's Abbeydale Picture House. Now in private ownership, but still hosting film shows and events to include the monthly Pedlars Corner Flea Market on the first Sunday of each month.






Just round the corner is *Broadfleld Road* where you can find 3 centres to include the **Sheffield Antiques Centre**. Here they are obviously 'in tune' with current trends. Within a stones throw is the **Heeley Bank Antiques Centre**, a lovely, buzzing antiques centre overlooked by the *Madina Mosque*, with it's Persian-style arches and beautiful blue-green tipped minarets and dome.

Through Nether Edge you come to Sharrowvale and Eccelsall Road - a delightful area filled with bustling independent shops and very close to The Botanical Gardens. In Sharrowvale don't miss **The Yard**, in nostalgic Steel Road. This is a great destination for quality antiques and interiors, set in a traditional cobbled street.

Kenwood Hall Hotel is a few minutes away and host to monthly antiques valuation days, held by TV antiques expert Charles Hanson and his team.

Sheffield is a fascinating city and worthy of a few days' visit, if you can spare the time. It is also a great base for touring the beautiful scenery and walks of the Peak District area and the wealth of shops featured in the 2019 edition of **The Antiques Tourist** guide. But - please check trading hours before setting off!

The villages consist of former workers cottages - workers in the mining, stone quarrying and other heavy industry that was so prevalent here until the mid to late 20th century. These rows of cottages have their own charm and are a sight worth seeing. Most villages and towns have a grand house - the former home of the mill or mine owner and

Elsecar is the epitome of this. A fine example of an early industrial village with stone miners and foundry workers cottages. Extensive estate workshops have been converted to retail units, workshops, tearooms and a large hall area for regular events. There is also the steam railway, and adjacent a canal wharf.





To the south and west of Sheffield is this group of towns.Whilst industry was less evident in these towns, it has still helped form the appearance of the towns and countryside.

At *Matlock* is the *Crich Tramway Village*. The *Tramway Museum Society* has been preserving tram cars since 1955 and the museum is home to some carefully restored models. Nearby

is the most famous cotton mill in England, *Cromford Mill*.This was built in 1771 by Richard Arkwright, and is now open to visitors.

Antique centres prosper here in *Matlock*, aswell as *Heanor*, *Ilkeston* and *Ashbourne*.






