Connecting the members of River View Baptist Church



The lives of God's people are to be characterized by the offering of thanksgiving to God; always, for everything, and in all circumstances (Eph. 5:19-20; Phil. 4:6). The people of God are to give thanks for blessings, spiritual and physical, in their own lives and in the lives of others. Thanksgiving is part of praise, prayer and worship.

Believers should remind themselves constantly to thank God for all His blessings. They can do this by making sure that thanksgiving accompanies all their requests to God (Col 4:2). They should particularly be thankful that God, in His love, has saved them and made them sharers in His grace and equipped them with faith, hope and love, and given them a part in the service of the gospel. By constantly offering thanks to God, Christians help counter the influence of sin. (Eph. 5:4). By failing to offer thanks to God, they fail to give Him the glory due to Him (Luke 17:16-18).

It has often been pointed out that thinking precedes thanking. When we are presented with a gift, it is because we think of its significance and meaning that we are led to express our appreciation. What, then, are the thoughts that, entertained by the Christian, lead to thanksgiving?

Somewhere in our thinking there should be thoughts of God and His instructions concerning thanksgiving. Perhaps we should start there. "God" what thoughts should fill our minds when we think of Him! Power, wisdom, goodness, peace, grace, love, care, provision: these are just some of the thoughts that cluster around the word God.

When Paul traces the downward path of mankind, he begins by saying that men, "when they knew Godglorified Him not as God, neither were thankful. (Romans 1:21)." Men were not thankful that they had a revelation of God. Indeed, they sought to suppress that knowledge and to evade its power.

Thanksgiving is thus really the product of careful cultivation. It is the fruit of a deliberate resolve to think about God and His revelation to us. By giving thanks we make manifest the fact that our lives are not controlled by the imperious cares and concerns of this life. Thanksgiving to God is a personal declaration that God is in control and that we bow our knees to Him. So, we must never cease to give Him thanks or forget who He is!
