**Pursuant to State of Nevada Executive Department Declaration of Emergency Directive 006, the Round Mountain Town Board meeting will hold public meetings via teleconference. Meeting will not be accessible from any Physical Location. Public comment can be given by calling 1-480-660-5349 and entering access code 556906.** Please provide your first and last name when prompted. If you get an error message regarding call capacity, please hang up, wait a few moments and try again. The Town Board Chairman will open public comment periods by announcement. Commenters must press 5 \* on the telephone keypads to notify administrators they wish to speak. Commenters will be called upon by name. Access will always be available during the meeting.

Persons are invited to submit comments in writing on the agenda items and/or attend and make comments on that item at the Board meeting.
