a. Review Draft of Bee-Keeping Ordinance

Mr. Zahn and Mrs. Heffernen introduced drafts of bee-keeping ordinances for discussion. The draft provided by Steve Zahn identified a general set of requirements while Jesse Heffernance draft included details of permit requirements, fines, and education for those who will conduct apian activities within the Village. The following considerations were discussed:

- Maximum number of hives (colonies) per acre
- Minimum distances from adjoining property lines
- Maintaining existing accessory structure setbacks
- Hedge or solid fencing to direct the flight of bees
- Location of water source for colonies
- Signage to caution others
- State Registration of bee colonies
- Village permit process and fees
- Maintenance of the apiary
- State inspections
