What is Sizoflor?

Sizoflor is a man made fabric consisting of long fibres compressed into a sheet. It comes in different colours, mat and metallic, widths and thicknesses. It is used in the florist industry for decoration but has been adopted by textile artists as it can be printed on by hand or computer, painted, stitched, manipulated by heat and won't fray. The sample, right, has a pattern rubbed onto

it using oil crayons and a rubbing plate. Sizoflor is especially good for making zapped rolled beads when painted or patterned and combined with other materials
