Thank you for your interest in teaching a class for the Lighthouse Homeschool Co-op! Before submitting your proposal, please carefully read through the following information.

1. Teaching a class is a commitment and we ask that you prayerfully consider whether you are able to teach at this time.

2. Prospective teachers need to be 17 years old or older, have been a member of the co-op for at least one year, and have signed the Statement of Faith. High school seniors interested in teaching must also have had a year's experience assisting in a class, and must be approved by the current board.

3. Submitting a course proposal does not guarantee that you will be teaching a course; this will be determined by the Lighthouse board, who reviews all of the proposals, evaluates the needs of the co-op, and determines space and scheduling.

4. If you are a new teacher, the board chair will contact you to complete the Criminal Background Check and Disclosure forms, as well as submit two letters of reference. Teaching is contingent upon the satisfactory return of these.

5. Please be clear about your preferences and when you cannot teach, but please also be as flexible as possible with your availability.

6. If you require childcare for your younger children while you are teaching, please indicate this on the space provided on the course proposal form. The parents of the children enrolled in your class can sign up to help in this area, and are generally happy to serve.

7. In order to accommodate as many students as possible, we require that your course be offered to a minimum of 6 students.

8. Once the schedule and classes are posted, changes cannot be made to the class times; however, the academics coordinators reserve the right to move the classroom location, if necessary.

9. Please remember that many classes often have waiting lists during enrollment time. If a space becomes available in your class, please refer to the waiting list and offer the available space to students in the order in which they appear on your waiting list. Please do not offer the open space to someone without first exhausting the waiting list.

10. Please be detailed and realistic about the homework requirements for your proposed class so that parents will have a clear picture of your expectations prior to enrolling their child in your class.
