Joe Windon is the Southeast Scouting Director for National Preps. National Preps is a scouting service used by over 300 colleges and Universities to identify and evaluate High School football prospects for colleges. Prior to his work with National Preps Joe spent three years at Georgia Military College (GMC) in Milledgeville Georgia. While at GMC Joe coached the offensive line and headed the player personnel duties. During the three seasons Joe was at GMC he helped produce 5 BCS, 7 FCS and 3 D2 signees on the offensive line. Joe also assisted in placing more than 50 players into D1 and D2 programs across the nation.

Prior to coaching at GMC Joe 9 years coaching High School Football in Georgia at McIntosh, Mt. Zion, Hardaway, and most recently at Carver High in Columbus Georgia. During his time as a High School Coach Joe played a part in assisting over 70 student athletes on to college football programs throughout the country. Notably over 40 of these young men into Division I programs.
