VOLUNTEER DUTIES

Event Grounds Lead Coordinator: (Ron Payne)

Shift Time: 6:30 a.m. - 3 p.m.

Work with Race Course Coordinator to set up the race course including setting up starting/finish line, directional signs and cones. Cleaning up race site and break down race. Make sure everything is returned to appropriate places. Position requires an outgoing personality and a great attitude!

Registration Lead Coordinator: (Judy Mitchell and Tina Bradfield)

Shift Time: 6:30 a.m. - 9 a.m.

Coordinate race packet pick-up, confirm releases for those under 18, help guide runners to start of the race, runners between registration and starting line/race director.

Volunteer Sign In Lead Coordinator: (Linda Biava, Janet Payne, Carrie Washkowiak)

Shift Time: 6:30 a.m. - 9 a.m.

Coordinate volunteer assignments with all Lead Coordinators and provide direction to appropriate stations.

Color Stations

Shift Time: 6:30 a.m. - 9 a.m.

Stands at one of the five color stations and throws color on runners as they run by.

- Arrive between 6:30am-7:00pm
- Check-In with the Volunteer Coordinator by the Main Stage (Carrie Washkowiak) She will advise you on what color station and location you'll be at.
- We will have a team huddle at or around 7:00am with Director Washkowiak
- Between 7:30am 7:45am begin making your way to your station
- Please note that if runners do not want color they will run to the right or left of your station, please respect their choice.

Water Stations

Shift Time: 6:30 a.m. - 9 a.m.

Provide water to racers and encourage them as they run/walk. Clean up your area prior to leaving your assigned area.

- Arrive between 6:30am-7:00pm
- Check-In with the Volunteer Coordinator by the Main Stage (Carrie Washkowiak) She will advise you on what water station and location you'll be at.
- We will have a team huddle at or around 7:00am with Director Washkowiak
- Between 7:30am 7:45am begin making your way to your station



Medical Area (Lead Coordinator- Butch Fields (TILTON AMBULANCE CREW)

Shift Time: 6:30 a.m. - 9 a.m.

Provide assistance as needed to medical team and/or injured runners.

Awards (Race Director- Ryan Washkowiak)

Shift Time: 9 a.m. - 12 p.m.

Work with timers/scorers, assist in posting results, tabulating and presenting awards. Clean up your area prior

to leaving the assigned area.

Post-Race Refreshment

Shift Time: 9 a.m. - 12 p.m.

Help direct runners to post-race refreshment area, provide post-race customer service. Clean up your area

prior to leaving your assigned area.

General Floaters

Shift Times: 6:30 a.m. - 9 a.m. or 9 a.m. - 12 p.m.

Provide assistance as needed (such as assisting race director, timers, VIPs, kids area, press or serving as

information/problem solving central). Clean up your area prior to leaving your assigned area.

Course Marshals (Lead Coordinator – Scott Mitchell)

Shift Time: 6:30 a.m. - 9 a.m.

Maintain traffic flow at cross streets on course.

Cheering Stations (ALL)

Shift Time: 7:30 a.m. - 10 a.m.

When you are finished your main duties - please cheer on our runners- especially when they are coming into

the finish line! Position requires an outgoing personality and a great attitude!

Driving Directions

From North Danville,

- 1. Turn right at the 1st cross street onto W 4th Street
- 2. Turn left at the 2nd cross street onto Forrest Street
- 3. Turn left onto Parker Ave
- 4. Turn right onto Tilton Rd
- 5. Turn right onto Mc Vey Ave
- 6. Following Mc Vey Avenue into Tilton Baseball Complex

Off I-74

- 1. Follow I-74 to 1st St in Tilton
- 2. Take exit 214 from I-74
- 3. Take N G Street
- 4. Turn Left onto E 5th St
- 5. Turn left at Traffic Light onto Tilton Rd
- 6. Turn left onto Mc Vey Ave (just past Village Hall)

Anywhere south of I-74

- 1. Head north on US Rt. 1 toward
- 2. Turn left onto E 14th Street (Tilton)
- 3. Continue onto E 5th St (Bridge)
- 4. Turn Right onto Tilton Road, at traffic Light
- 5. Turn left onto Mc Vey Ave (Just past Village Hall)
