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What have we improved?

- Peer observations outside to ensure that our activities and engagement with the children are of a continuous standard
- Parent questionnaires were given out in March. We are analyzing them and will let you know the results soon.
- Staff have attended various training including food hygiene, safety, Early Help, Promoting Children's Self-Regulation, and Listening and Attention.
- We've looked at collaborative observations, and more timely updates on Tapestry.
- We have booked some sessions with Louise Brogan from Play Wild!
- The children are attending story sessions at Banwell Primary School.
- Staff have been looking at the way we use resources to stimulate the environment. In education, the term 'loose parts' is used to refer to playable objects that are not permanently fixed in place. Items like wooden blocks, cotton reels, stones, twigs, wooden planks etc. can be moved, stacked, carried, adapted, re-shaped, extended and so on by the children to create their own play journey.
