

Sunday Reading Reflection: Wisdom - In the first reading, God asks the new young king, Solomon "Ask something of me and I will give it to you." We might consider: what would I ask of the Lord if he posed the same question to me? Solomon answered "... an understanding heart to judge your people and to distinguish right from wrong..... to govern this vast people of yours." This was a great answer, because if Solomon asked for riches, without wisdom he could be destroyed! For power? Without wisdom it could corrupt him! For all the pleasure he could imagine? Without wisdom it could consume and ruin him! And unfortunately we have often seen this to be the case in young people who suddenly receive any or all of these through athletics, stardom, or politics. But in asking for Wisdom to govern God's people, Solomon was asking to see things as God does. With wisdom he (or we!) would know how to deal with whatever else comes – riches, power, pleasures or their alternatives - poverty, weakness, or sufferings - in the way God wants and in the way that is good for us and lead to happiness. Ultimately the goods (or lack thereof) of creation are meant to lead us to the one good, the only good that can fulfill us, God Himself. St. Ignatius says, therefore, we should not prefer riches or poverty, power or weakness, popularity or rejection, or anything else, except insofar as it leads us to God; we give God permission to choose what is best for us. A good exercise might be to examine: What if God asked me "What would you ask of me?" What would I find in our heart? Even though it might not be directed quite toward God yet, that's okay, we can ask God for that grace. And then we might consider that ultimately we want - through Faith, Hope, and Love - God Himself and whatever leads us to Him, for that is Wisdom and leads to JOY.
