- VENUE:** Iceworld Olympic Ice Rink, 1179 Beaudesert Road, ACACIA RIDGE Qld, 4110.
- ICE SURFACE:** The dimensions of the ice surface are 60m x 26m.
- DIVISIONS:** **Crossland - Singles: Mens & Ladies. NB* One program only**

Preliminary to Senior **FS Program Only**

NB* The overall Crossland Rosebowl will be presented to a skater for the most outstanding performance in levels Preliminary to Basic Novice A
- DATES:** Friday 7th and Saturday 8th April 2017
- TIMES:** Starting times will be advised after the close of entries.
- DRAW:** Draws for initial Start Order will take place on **Friday 31st March at 6.15pm** at the Iceworld Acacia Ridge.
- ENTRIES:** Entries must be submitted via the ONLINE entry form ONLY @ www.ifsc.org.au and must be received prior to the closing date. All entries must be accompanied by full payment to be valid.

Payment is to be made via the online entry form and must be done at the time of entry.

NB** **No Late entries will be accepted.**

Should you require assistance with regard to the online process you should contact the club before the 25th March 2017.

Closing date for entries: 5pm Thursday 30th March 2017

ENTRY FEES: Crossland Rosebowl Entry Fee all levels : \$45.00 per entry

Withdrawals: Refund – only with medical certificate prior to the draw. NB A 10% deduction from the entry fee will apply.

No refunds for withdrawal after the draw on 31st March 2017

MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS: **All competitors must be a member of their local club and ISQ, or alternatively, a current 2017 Aussie Skate member skating at a Queensland ice rink.**

MARKING:

6.0 System will be used for all Aussie Skate levels, all marking will be closed marking
ISU Judging System will be used for Preliminary to Senior Levels.

Medals/Trophies:

Will be awarded to first three place-getters in each division.

MUSIC

NB** 2 copies of each music programme must be supplied for each entry as follows:

- be provided on Compact Disc,
- contain only one track per CD
- be marked with:
 - competitor's name,
 - division (e.g. Junior Ladies)
 - program description (e.g. "FreeSkate")
 - exact running time of the music (not skating time).

Please ensure that your music is recorded at an appropriate level. No adjustments to levels will be made during the track being played.
