RIVENHALL PARISH COUNCIL MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON 6TH NOVEMBER 2012.

Present: Cllrs. Abbott, Bills, Wright, Prime, Turner, Brailey and Clark.

677.. To receive apologies for absence.

There were no apologies for absence received.

- 678. Disclosure of Pecuniary Interests relating to matters on the Agenda. Cllrs. Prime and Turner made Non-Pecuniary disclosures relative to item 681(iii), both being members of the Millennium Committee.
- 679.. To approve and sign the Minutes of the meeting held on 2nd October 2012. The minutes were unanimously approved and then signed by the Chairman.

680.. Public Forum for 10 minutes.

The following matters were brought to the attention of Members:

- Lack of road markings along Rickstones Road.
- Stone chippings still require removal from Rickstones Road.
- Various extra contents in the sheds at the Village Hall.
- Costs/savings of the proposed ECC part-night lighting of street lights.
- TV programme re the safety of our roads, in particular Oak Road, Rivenhall End.
- Footpath No.1 and brambles emanating from the Academy fence line.
- Rubbish collecting in the copse opposite Rectory Lane.

681.. Matters for Discussion.

- <u>To consider a possible review of the Parish Plan.</u>
 It was agreed that a working group comprising Cllrs. Prime, Clark and Turner reassess the Parish Plan and submit a report to the February 2013 meeting.
- ii. <u>Proposed 30mph speed limit along Oak Road/Henry Dixon Road.</u>

Members **unanimously supported** this proposed reduction in the speed limit and the Clerk will notify ECC accordingly; also requesting that the remaining 40mph, along to Fair-Rest on Braxted Road, be retained.

Solagen have quoted the sum of ± 180.00 to change the VAS on Henry Dixon Road.

iii. <u>Purchase of the annual Christmas Tree.</u>

There is \pounds 208.00 remaining in the budget allocation for the purchase of the Christmas Tree.

Proposed by Cllr. Clark, seconded by Cllr. Wright and unanimously agreed that an appropriate tree is selected up to the value of $\pounds 250.00$ including delivery.

iv. <u>Purchase of additional/replacement trees within the parish.</u>

Proposed by Clir. Prime, seconded by Clir. Bills and unanimously agreed that ornamental trees, additional planters and compost be purchased at an estimated cost of £110.00.

v. <u>Dog faeces warning notices</u>.

Following the receipt of a complaint regarding dog faeces in St. Mary's Road **it was agreed** that after a further inspection of the Albert Moss Playing Field, to request the BDC Dog Warden to erect appropriate official warning signs at both sites.

The purchase of a further dog waste bin will be included in the budget for 2013/14.

vi. <u>ECC Highways maintenance.</u>

ECC have reinstated some footways and road sections within the parish. Still outstanding are the repairs to the footway under the Railway Bridge and the bushes obscuring the height restriction notices in Church Road.

There are uneven paving slabs along the footway in Beech Road that require attention.

A copy of the communication sent to the Highways Agency regarding additional signage along the A12 approaching the Rivenhall End slips be sent to ECC with a request that they make representations to the Highways Agency in support of these requests.

The Highways Agency is to be requested to clear the stones and rubbish from the triangle at the A12 junction with Oak Road.

vii. <u>General maintenance.</u>

The Maintenance Contractor will be requested to undertake the following: Clear the rubbish from the copse opposite Rectory Lane along Rickstones Road.

Remove the concrete slabs from Mr. Brice's' land (former play area) and relocate them to the site of the new planters in Rivenhall End. Dig holes for planting the new trees.
