## **History of Pentecost**

The word "Pentecost" in the Greek represents Liberty, Freedom, and Jubilee. The Festival of Pentecost takes place exactly 50 days after Easter. Through the salvation of Christ, (the symbol of Pentecost) we are liberated or freed from Satan's oppression and the bondage of sin.

A Festival can be defined as a lively celebration! In the book of Exodus God commands that we celebrate a festival to Him.

In our celebration of traditional holidays we should not exclude the biblical **Holy-Days**. The motive for Christians to celebrate the biblical holidays is to honor what the Lord has instituted.

Leviticus 23:1-2 states (NLT)

The Lord said to Moses, "Give the following instructions to the people of Israel. These are the Lord's appointed festivals, which you are to proclaim as official days for holy assembly.


