Resuming In-Person Worship: Members of our church are working to create a plan for safely returning to in-person worship. The next step is to share this plan with the church council and approve a plan. Keep in mind that in order to do these things well, they take time. As soon as the plan is approved and a date is established, I will be sending a letter to all members of the congregation with more information. I appreciate your patience as we work through this process in order to keep everyone healthy.

We hope that you are able to continue your giving to the church during this time in order to give thanks for God's presence and support the ways that God continues to be at work through our ministries.

Church Cleaning: During the pandemic, Tom is still working hard to keep our buildings clean and disinfected. The office and King's Kupboard are disinfected daily, and are in the process of being deep-cleaned for whenever we are able to return to church.
