

Holy Thursday – Mass will be livestreamed at 7:00pm. Sign up to pray for 30 minutes to an hour at either parish in front of the Tabernacle from 8-12 by calling the office or Sign-Up Genius at:

https://www.signupgenius.com/go/30E0B4DADAF22ABFC1-adorationweston Please limit the group to no more than 10. Good Friday – Stations of the Cross will be livestreamed at 11:30am (kids) & 12:00pm (adult). Passion will be livestreamed at 3:00pm.

Easter Vigil - I will be joining St. Wenceslaus at 8:30pm with my brother priests (group of no more than 10). This mass will be livestreamed on St. Wenceslaus' website at: http://www.stwencwahoo.org/

Easter Sunday – Mass will be livestreamed at 8:00am. I will be giving out an Easter Blessings after mass in front of St. John's Church until 9:45am, drive thru fashion (in cars). I will be in Touhy in front of St. Vitus Church from 10:15am-11:00am for Easter Blessings, also in drive thru fashion.

Mass Times – "St. Vitus (Touhy) & St. John Nepomucene Church (Weston)" Facebook Masses are 8:00am Sunday and daily (except Saturdays). No 8:00am mass Thursday or Friday this week.
