### **SICK POLICY**

Common Winter Viruses—students may not attend school with the following conditions:

- Chicken Pox (5 days or until all sores have been scabbed over)
- Whooping Cough-Pertussis
- Active Diarrhea–2 or more bouts (exclusion of 24 hours after the last bout)
- Persistent Vomiting
- Escalating Fever above 101F
- Pink Eye- Conjunctivitis (until 24 hours of treatment)
- Strep Throat
- Undiagnosed Rash
