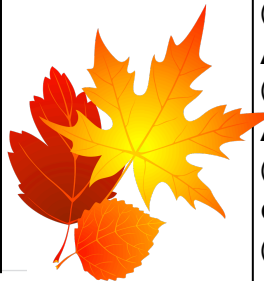

Harroon Ali who recently purchased the gas station on the corner of Walton and Ritchie? He spoke about wanting to be a part of the community and gave us a donation.

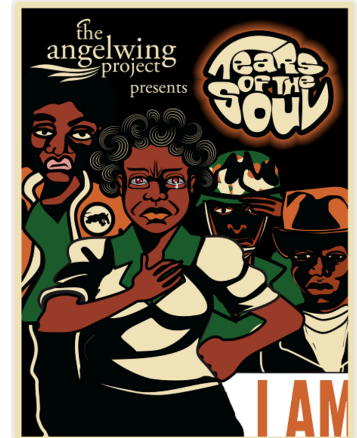
