

Dear Parishioners, My prayers are with you all during this time of separation from sharing Holy Mass together. Fr. Vandewalle Mass Times – "St. Vitus (Touhy) & St. John Nepomucene Church (Weston)" Facebook Masses are 8:00am Sunday and daily (except Saturdays).

Stations of the Cross will be next Friday at 8:25am (children's) and 5:45pm (regular). Holy Week Schedule is TBD.

Lenten Confessions – Saturday evening 4:00-5:00pm, Wednesday 6:00-6:30pm (or until finished) or by appointment.. They will be held at the back entrance of the convent which is accessed from the southeast corner of the gym. I will be inside the convent at the window. Please park in the east parking lot of the school gym. In the case of inclement weather, confessions will be heard inside the gym. Gym doors will be open, please enter one at a time and wait for the person ahead of you to leave before entering. I will be behind the screen.

Giving Options – (1) Feel free to mail in your check, (2) Many banks are willing to set up direct deposits weekly or monthly, (3) We are looking into online giving and (4) Contact the parish if you would like to know where drop box will be for both parishes. And as always, once again, thank you for your generosity to St. John's and St. Vitus'.

Palms – Palms will be distributed on Palm Sunday (April 5th). I will be handing them out at St. Vitus from 11:30am-12:30pm, drive thru fashion. Then at St. John's from 1:00pm-2:00pm, also, drive thru fashion. There will be palms left in both churches afterwards.
