

Teething and Drooling

Milestones

(0-24 months)

1 month	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Drooling rare
2-4 months	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Drooling seen when mouthing objects
3-6 months	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Drooling seen with teething & mouth around 5-6 months • Eruption of teeth with more chewing & biting experience (5-6 months)
5- 9 months	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Drooling when on back/belly/sitting/ babbling; during or after feeding & while teething • Bottom two front teeth erupt (5-9 months) • Top two front teeth (6-10 months) • Bottom lateral incisors (7-20 months) • Top lateral incisors (8-10 months)
9-12 months	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No drooling during movements, only with teething • Bottom first molars (10-12 months)
12-15 months	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Some drooling with teething • Top first molars (14-16 months)
15-18 months	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No drooling during movements, only with teething • Bottom cuspids (16-18 months)
18-21 months	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No drooling with learned hand movements, only with teething • Top cuspids (18-20 months)
21-24 months	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No drooling • Bottom second molars (20-24 months) • Top second molars (24-30 months)
