The Creative Textile show in Canberra was very good, Not a huge venue but I spent the whole day there browsing the stands and doing a couple of workshops. Bought a fabric hardening product called Powertex which I am trying out on a crochet table cloth, making it into a bust using a foam head as a resist.

Went to several art markets in Canberra, saw lots of public sculptures, then toured the Gallery, Portrait Gallery, National Archives and grounds between these venues. Very scenic place Canberra but easy to get lost.

I'm working on an idea for a wearable art entry into the Festival of Quilts run by the Quilters Guild held at the Quilt and Craft fair in November. The theme this year is Pearl, which was very challenging to apply to wearable art. Fortunately there was a luscious fabric vendor at the Creative Textile show who had blush metallic evening fabrics, sequin fabrics and laces to inspire my imagination. So now I have the making of unique and appropriate piece for the 30th Anniversary Pearl theme.

I also found a fun and easy technique at the show called Orizomegami by Kristin Lawson, folding patterns into fabric or paper like origami, clipping the folded paper together and allowing dye to seep into the corners and folds making wonderful patterns. Very easy and suitable for kids if you use Viva paper towel and food colouring. Get the book from www.artwearpublication.com.au sample middle picture below.

Below is a photo of my results from an ice dying workshop we did at the Collective. The silk velvet worked the best which is the bright pink fabric on the left.

My favourite piece of art in Canberra was a cluster of flowers that were made from 2ltr plastic milk cartons, bike tyres and solar lights pictured right. It was at m16Artspace.
