AN ORDINANCE AMENDING VILLAGE CODE

(Chapter 2—Streets And Rights-Of-Way, Subchapter 2—Objects Within The Right-Of-Way)

BEITORDAINED by the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Lily Lake, Kane County, Illinois, that the Village Code, as amended, be further amended as follows:

§ 1. Amending Village Code

Chapter 2—Streets And Rights-Of-Way, Subchapter 2—Objects Within The Right-Of-Way, is amended by adding the following as § 212 and renumbering the remaining sections of Chapter 2 accordingly:

§ 212. Depositing snow within the right-of-way prohibited

No person, as defined in § 109, shall cause ice or snow to be plowed or removed from any shopping center, parking lot, or other commercial, institutional, public, or private service area or driveway, and deposited upon a public highway or street or along the shoulder or edge of a public highway or street within the village. Snow or ice from a residential driveway or sidewalk may be deposited within the right-of-way only if it is at least two feet from the edge of the roadway.

§ 2. Repealer

Any ordinance or any provision of any ordinance in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance is, to the extent of such conflict, repealed.

§ 3. Effective Date

This ordinance is fully effective from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
