
NBN has led important education on Asset Based Community Development in Winston-Salem, offering Race, Class, and Power workshops to more than 95 participants.

NBN reached record membership in its Timebanking exchange-which utilizes person hours as currency in place of cash—and became the sixth largest Timebanking effort in the US and the only active program in North Carolina.

NBN's Grassroots Grant Program was featured on The Grassroots Grantmaking Council's website. The program has assisted over 35 neighborhood groups with grants totaling more than \$44,000.

Programs and Services Offered

Neighbors In Action

A training and skill-building vehicle designed to expand leadership and organizational development; Workshop and Working Groups

Ongoing learning opportunities open to a wide spectrum of neighborhood leaders, grassroots activists and community advocates;

Timebanking

A community development concept that facilitates the exchange of skills, talents, and services within a community. Rather than money, the energy that it runs on is love, kindness, caring, compassion, encouragement and moral duty.

Organizing

A process used to bring the talents, resources, knowledge, and skills of people in a community together to transform themselves and their neighborhoods; **Technical Assistance** Guides neighborhood community-

based groups through a specific set of assessments and processes leading to the creation of a short-term action plan or a long term strategic plan; **Grassroots** Grants Provided to groups to assist them with moving on desired action items.
