

<i>Bridle: Short Loop*</i>	3.9 miles, moderate	white circles
<i>Bridle: Middle Loop*</i>	5.5 miles, moderate	blue circles
<i>Bridle: Long Loop*</i>	9.3 miles, moderate	red circles
<i>Campground/Pool</i>	.8 miles, easy	white triangles
<i>Fall Mountain</i>	4.1 miles, moderate	orange triangles
<i>Hattaway Mountain</i>	2.0 miles, strenuous	orange squares
<i>Laurel</i>	.6 miles, easy	red hexagons
<i>Morrow Mountain**</i>	2.6 miles, moderate	blue triangles
<i>Mountain Loop</i>	.8 miles, easy	red squares
<i>Quarry</i>	.6 miles, easy	blue diamonds
<i>Rocks**</i>	1.3 miles, easy	blue squares
<i>Sugarloaf Mountain</i>	2.8 miles, strenuous	orange diamonds
<i>Three Rivers</i>	.8 miles, easy	blue hexagons
