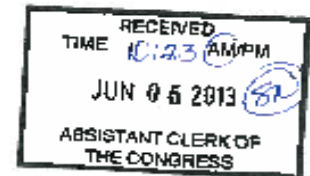

As Chairman of Governmental Operations Committee, I am reporting an incident to you. On Friday May 31 Chief Red Eagle called my office, spoke to my investigator, and threatened my investigator with termination if he did not stop an investigation he was working on. Additionally, Chief Red Eagle declared to my investigator that "you will not touch" a certain employee. I take these statements as a threat to an employee of mine and also beleive that Chief is using his power and authority to influence not only an investigation but also personnel issues.

I intend to review the Osage Nation code and take whatever action is provided for by law and will keep Congress informed of my actions.
