## Is Breastfeeding Going Well? \*\*

To know that breastfeeding is going well, answer these questions

when the baby is 5 - 7 days old.

If you have answered <u>NO</u> to any of these questions, there may be some problems with feeding. Please call your pediatrician and/or a Lactation Consultant. (see other side)

- 1. Is the baby having several bowel movements in 24 hours that are mustard yellow with curds in them? ("poop you can scoop", not just a smear) Yes or No
- 2. Is the baby wetting 6-8 diapers in 24 hours? Yes or No
- 3. Do the breasts feel full before feeding and softer after feeding? Yes or No
- 4. If the mother had initial nipple soreness, is this resolved? Yes or No
- 5. Do you **hear swallowing** when the baby is breastfeeding? Yes or No

- 6. Is the baby eating at least 8 times in 24 hours? Yes or No
- 7. Does the baby seem satisfied after a feeding? Yes or No
- 8. Are there any sore, tender, or red and firm areas in either breast? Yes or No
- 9. Has the baby started gaining 1/2 1 ounce per day? Yes or No
