The eligibility requirements are as follows:

- o Applicant must be eligible for graduation from Grade 12 at a high school in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta in 2020
- o Applicant must be enrolled in a post-secondary (college or university) education program in the field of Agriculture with the intention of beginning classes in 2020 (copy of proof of enrollment and class start date must be included with application)
- o Applicant must have achieved a grade of 87% or higher in their Grade 12 biology or chemistry class (proof of grade required)
- o Applicant must submit a 1000 word essay on the following topic: What is the effect of Industrial Hemp on the rural Canadian economy?
- Applicant must complete application form in full

Applications must be submitted by May 1st 2020. A winner will be chosen by June 10th 2020.

A winner, who meets all of the eligibility requirements, will be chosen based on the structure, spelling, grammar, logical reasoning and use of factual information and bibliography of their essay. The winner's school will be notified so that arrangements can be made for a PIHG representative to attend the graduation ceremony. The winner will also be notified by email. The winner must be in attendance at the ceremony to accept the award.
