RURAL MUNCIPALITY OF MOOSE CREEK NO. 33

BYLAW NO. 04-2018

A BYLAW TO PREVENT AND CONTROL CLUBROOT

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Moose Creek No. 33 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. This bylaw may be referred to as the "Clubroot Bylaw".
- 2. The purpose of this Bylaw is to establish the requirements for clubroot reporting, notification and management.
- 3. The Pest Control Act authorizes municipalities and officers to act in relation to clubroot.
 - a) Section 4 of *The Pest Control Act* states that "every person shall take measures to destroy, control and prevent the spread of all pests on any land or other premises owned, occupied or controlled by him"
- 4. In this bylaw:
 - a) "Officer" shall mean an officer within the meaning of The Pest Control Act;
 - b) "Owner" and "Occupant" as defined in The Municipalities Act
 - c) "Municipality" shall mean the Rural Municipality of Moose Creek No. 33
- 5. Every owner(s) and/or occupant(s) of any land in the Municipality shall notify the Municipality in which the land is located of the presence of clubroot, within 30 business days of becoming aware of the same.
- 6. Notification of the presence of clubroot shall be in writing and submitted to the office of the Rural Municipality of Moose Creek No. 33
- 7. Where the officer believes that a person has contravened any provision of this Bylaw, a Bylaw Violation Notice, Schedule "A" shall be served either personally or by mail.
- 8. The Bylaw Violation Notice shall be deemed to have been served:
 - a) On the expiration of 24 hours after it is posted, if the notice is mailed; or
 - b) On the day of actual delivery, if the notice is served personally
- 9. Every owner(s) and/or occupant(s) of any land where clubroot has been identified through notification within the Municipality, shall:
 - a) take measures to manage and prevent the spread of clubroot
 - b) develop a Clubroot Management Agreement with the assistance of an agrologist currently practicing with the Saskatchewan Institute of Agrologists and provide the officer with a copy of the agreement within 30 business days of notification.
 - c) The officer will ensure that the Clubroot Management Agreement meets the minimum requirements of The Saskatchewan Clubroot Management Plan and will execute the agreement with the owner(s) and/or occupant

- 10. In Lieu of prosecution, the person who has contravened the provisions of this Bylaw, a voluntary payment up to the amount of \$500.00 may be requested, and shall be indicated on the Bylaw Violation Notice.
- 11. When a formal agreement between the owner(s) and/or occupant(s) and the officer cannot be reached, the officer shall issue an order as per Section 19 of *The Pest Control Act*
