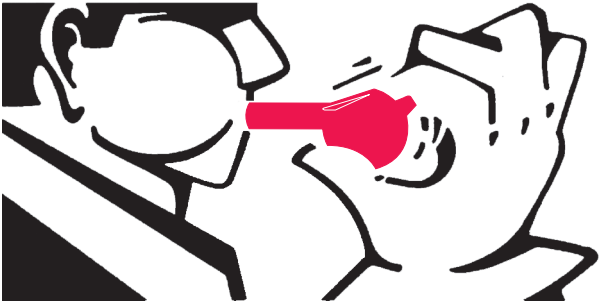


Blow the Whistle on Impaired Drivers!

Ohio law enforcement agencies arrest nearly 50,000 drivers a year for driving under the influence. Most people learn a lesson and do not continue to drive impaired.

However, more than 360,000 drivers did not learn their lesson and went on to be convicted again—some as many as 20 times! You can help the Ohio State Highway Patrol get tough on drivers who continue to drink and drive or those who drive with a suspended license after one or more OVI convictions.

If you see an impaired driver on the highway, or if you know someone who is driving without a license after an OVI conviction, **blow the whistle!** Call our toll-free hot line anywhere in Ohio and a state trooper will answer your call. We want drunk and destructive drivers off the highways as much as you do.

Guide for Detecting Impaired Drivers

- Driver looks bleary-eyed or his/her movements are slow and inaccurate
- Makes wide turns
- Straddles center line
- Suddenly swerves or continuously weaves
- May nearly strike another vehicle or object
- Stops in roadway without cause
- Uses brakes erratically
- Drives into opposing traffic
- Signals to turn one way, then turns another
- Follows traffic ahead too closely or drives quickly into traffic ahead and brakes suddenly
- Responds slowly to traffic signals
- Drives without headlights at night
- Accelerates rapidly or drives at high speeds
- Drives very slowly
- Makes abrupt or illegal turns
- Drives a path which is not on the designated roadway
