

Law Enforcement Range Standard Operating Procedure (SOP)

PURPOSE

- Provide a safe place for Law Enforcement to practice at up to 75 yards.
- Provide an auxiliary pistol range for members

CONTACTS

- Club officers listed at the front gate or club house door

SAFETY/RULES

- No pistol shooting steel closer than 25 yards, and shoot at steel targets head on to prevent ricochets.
- No shotgun or rifle shooting at steel targets.
- Authorized LEO do not need a club vote to save the range for their use, however a club officer or the club secretary needs to be notified.
- No use any ammunition that damages steel targets.
- Must use steel targets or paper targets on back board, and no glass or plastic targets.
- All targets must be placed at berms.
- Use of exploding or organic targets is prohibited.
- You bring, you remove it and take it home. (targets/trash/etc).
- All shooters must shoot from same firing line.
- Must listen to, and abide by, on-site club officers or designated club Range Safety officer (RSO).
- When safety allows, spent shell casings must be picked up.
- NO CIVILIAN FULL AUTO or SIMULATED FULL AUTO!
- All general club rules must be followed.
- Notify club officers of any damage to the range or targets.

USE OF THE RANGE IS A PRIVLEDGE. VIOLATION OF THE RULES COULD RESULT IN THE LOSS OF THE USE OF THE RANGE, OR LOSS OF MEMBERSHIP

MAINTENANCE

- Grass cutting, brush removal
- Rock removal from berm
- Targets, including steel and backer boards
- Trash
- Bench maintenance
