New Minor Forcing Raising Partner's Preempts Declarer Play: Establishing Your Suits Declarer Play: Avoid the Danger

Declarer Play – The skill of establishing your long suits may seem simple but after this seminar you will do it with confidence and understand how entries affect your declaring decisions. **Declarer Play** – Avoidance play is one of the most common techniques a declarer can employ to disrupt and frustrate the defense. Learn hold up plays, the Rule of 7, and the Bath Coup!
