SERIAL CASTING THE PEDIATRIC LOWER EXTREMITY IN THE OUTPATIENT SETTING

This course is intended for the pediatric physical therapist practicing in the outpatient or private setting. Many pediatric clinicians in outpatient clinics are seeking out information on the use and efficacy of casting and may feel intimidated without the support of a large hospital system. This course will outline the indications, benefits, and use of serial casting the lower extremity. The diagnoses of idiopathic toe walking and cerebral palsy are described and how casting can impact your treatment. The session will also include a demonstration of a casting application with concurrent discussion of materials that can be used in the private and outpatient setting.
