BYLAW NO. 12-2016

A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MOOSE CREEK NO. 33 TO PROVIDE FOR RECOVERING PROTECTIVE SERVICES COSTS

THE COUNCIL OF THE R.M. OF MOOSE CREEK NO. 33 OF ALAMEDA IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN, enacts as follows:

- 1. In this bylaw:
 - a) "Administrator" shall mean the administrator of the municipality;
 - b) "Council" shall mean the council of the municipality; and
 - c) "Municipality" shall mean the Rural Municipality of Moose Creek #33.
- 2. The cost of fire prevention, suppression and emergency response services shall be
 - a) billed at a rate of \$500.00/hour
 - b) billed for any and all consumables used at the sight, at a rate of cost recovery plus 10% for inflation, and
 - c) billed directly on the persons who receive the service.
- 3. The Council may authorize the Administrator to add to the taxes of any property owned by the person referenced in Section 2 of this bylaw any amount which remains unpaid at the end of the calendar year or 60 days after the person has been invoiced for said services, whichever is earlier.
- 4. Bylaw No. 6-2012 is hereby repealed.
