On June 8th, we held our 18th annual spring recital at the Oconto Falls PAC, where our beautiful dancers of all ages took the stage to show what they had learned during our program.

Here are some fantastic ways to help your child succeed in dance!

- Make sure they attend every class!
- Record them during parent observations so they can easily practice at home with a video.
- Purchase the music they are dancing to and play it a few times a week. Ask them to show you the dance! The musical artists are listed in this newsletter and are also available online, www.christiandancecompany.com

Important Dates

- Parent Observations are held the last classes of January, March and May.
- ✤ January Parent Observations are January 27 and 28.
- Second tuition payment is due on or before Saturday February1st. Please leave payments in the gray lock-box that will be located in the upper room, table to the left.
- Thursday February 13: Final shoe and attire order of the year will be held in the lower level. If you are looking to order new ballet shoes, jazz shoes, tap shoes, tights, attire, etc. you may do so on this night. First, Second and Third Group were only sized for one pair of shoes. You will need to come this night to be sized for your second pair. If there are any free, gently used shoes, we will have them out for you to take. Please feel free to bring along gently used shoes to donate. You can come anytime from 4:00-7:00 PM. If you are ordering shoes, your dancer must be present so that we can fit him/her correctly. Please keep in mind there will be no more orders following this date!

- Thursday March 5 and April 2: All Tuesday classes~ Scheduled Makeup Lesson~ Normal Class Times
