Children's Chapel

Children gather with the Children's Chaplain in the courtyard before the 11:00 am service. They process through the church over to the Children's Chapel in the Parish House and return to the church to be with their parents at the Peace. This is a wonderful opportunity for kids to experience worship with instruction that is child friendly.



Christian Formation

St. Mark's offers a variety of excellent programs to enhance our faith, our community, and our sense of self as spiritual beings. Come grow in wisdom and knowledge.

Christian Formation programs are available for all ages each Sunday during the school year from 9:30 to 10:50 am.

NURSERY. Nursery is available from 8:15 am to noon for newborn to age four. The nursery is located on the first floor in the Parish House.

CHILDREN. Children's classes for age 3 to grade 5 are located upstairs in the Parish House.

YOUTH. Youth classes for grades 6-12 are located in the Founders Hall basement.

ADULTS. Adult classes for post high school and up are located in Osborne Hall in Founders Hall.

Ministries

Ministries at St. Mark's includes Service, Worship, Evangelism, Education, Parish, and Stewardship.

SERVICE. Our Outreach Committee provides many service opportunities in the community and beyond. We provide preschool education through La Escuelita San Marcos for Latino children. We support Ranson Middle School with food, school supplies, uniforms and summer camps. We sponsor youth and adult mission trips, and much more.

WORSHIP. The worship team is responsible for planning worship services in conjunction with the Rector. This team is made up of representatives from altar guild, music, lectors, ushers, chalice bearers, children's chaplains, and acolytes.

EDUCATION. Christian education and formation offered at St. Mark's includes Sunday School for all ages. Youth group, Vacation Bible School (VBS), confirmation classes, Lenten series, and family formation events are also offered. The Christian Formation team develops curriculum and recruits teachers for all ages.

EVANGELISM. The Welcome Committee helps assist visitors and new members find their place at St. Mark's. We maintain coffee hour as well as the greeter ministries. Newcomer classes are offered once or twice a year for those who have recently joined or are interested in learning more about the Episcopal Church and specifically St. Mark's.

PARISH. Our Parish Life, Pastoral Care, and small groups help take care of the needs of our parishioners. Parish life assists in parish-wide events providing both fellowship and faith. Pastoral Care tends to the needs of our parishioners with meals, transportation, prayer shawls, visitations, and much more. Small groups offer additional opportunities for faith and fellowship in more specific settings.

STEWARDSHIP. Stewardship consists of the management and care of our property, grounds, and finances. Groups that fall under this ministry are Buildings & Grounds, Finance, and our Every Member Canvas Campaign.
