

RESOLUTION OF THE ELECTORS OF THE TOWN OF FARMINGTON
CONCERNING THE TOWN TAX LEVY

Whereas, since 1985, Section 60.10 (2) (a) Wisconsin Statutes, authorizes the Town Electors to delegate to the Town Board, the authority to raise money, including levying taxes, to pay for expenses of the Town, and

Whereas, if this authority to levy taxes is delegated, the Town Board would continue to conduct a public hearing on the budget, but the Town of Farmington would not be required to hold a special meeting for the purpose of adopting a Town tax levy, and

Whereas, the Town Board is responsible for developing and implementing the Town budget

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ELECTORS OF THE TOWN OF FARMINGTON:

That the Farmington Town Board, pursuant to Section 60.10 (2) (a), Wisconsin Statutes, is hereby authorized to raise the Town tax levy, in a total sum not to exceed Two-Hundred and Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$ 250,000.00). This delegation of authority is general and continuing for future years until rescinded at a subsequent Town meeting by the Town Electors.
