Concretely, this means that from Monday on you can come to daily mass, of course with face mask and keeping social distancing. And on Sunday June 21, 2020, you can come to Sunday Mass. Both have a restriction to 50 people in attendance only.

It was also a moment in which the Church wanted to remind us that it is necessary to be with Christ in order to know Christ. SUNDAY 6/21

Archdiocese of Newark announces Phase II: Reopening of Churches

Monday, June 15, 2020, Phase Two of reopening churches in the Archdiocese will begin, following all public health guidelines and once pastors determine they can safely do so.

Phase Two continues the dispensation from the Sunday obligation and Easter Duty, maintains all provisions of Phase One and permits weekday Masses.

Following Phase One, churches will be permitted to celebrate public weekday Masses and funerals with very specific restrictions, such as the strict practice of social distancing, use of masks and limited number of people present. Sunday Mass will continue with a maximum capacity of 50 people. (For more information please visit us at our Parish website <http://saintfrancisdesaleslodinj.org>).

El lunes 15 de Junio de 2020, comenzará la Fase Dos de las iglesias reabiertas en la Arquidiócesis, siguiendo todas las pautas de salud pública y una vez que los pastores determinen que pueden hacerlo de manera segura.

La Fase Dos continúa la dispensación de la obligación dominical y el Deber de Pascua, mantiene todas las disposiciones de la Fase Uno y permite Misas de lunes a viernes.

Después de la Fase Uno, se permitirá a las iglesias celebrar misas y funerales públicamente entre semana con restricciones muy específicas, como la práctica estricta de distanciamiento social, el uso de máscaras y un número limitado de personas presentes. La misa dominical continuará con una capacidad máxima de 50 personas. (Para obtener más información, visite la pagina web de nuestra parroquia <http://saintfrancisdesaleslodinj.org>).

Na segunda-feira, 15 de junho de 2020, a Fase Dois das igrejas reabertas na Arquidiocese começará, seguindo todas as diretrizes de saúde pública e depois que os pastores determinarem que podem fazê-lo com segurança.

A Fase Dois continua a dispensa da obrigação dominical e do Dever de Páscoa, mantém todas as disposições da Fase 1 e permite missas de segunda a sexta-feira.

Após a Fase Um, as igrejas poderão celebrar missas e funerais publicamente nos dias de semana com restrições muito específicas, como a prática estrita de distanciamento social, o uso de máscaras e um número limitado de pessoas presentes.
