
Osage Production Information

The chart below shows the general trend that Osage oil production has been in for the last 13 years. The data comes from information presented to the Council each month by auditor Jim Swan. We see nothing but increases since 2007, with the steepest incline beginning in 2011, thru current. Come March, 2014, I expect that a similar chart will display an even more radical incline as the increase in production from the Burbank CO₂ Enhanced Oil Recovery gets into the records.
