This week, sees the start of courses at the CXC – CSEC level which include English, Mathematics, Human and Social Biology, Social Studies, Office Administration, Principles of Business and Accounts, Economics and EDPM. As the Centre aspires to meet the needs of the learning public, two new CXC Caribbean Advanced Proficiency Examination (CAPE) subjects, Communication Studies and Law have been introduced into the curriculum. All CAPE courses, i.e., Sociology, Pure Mathematics, Economics, Accounting, Management of Business, Law and Communication Studies are scheduled to begin during the week of September 12, 2011. The realization of these subject areas will allow students to move closer to the attainment of the CAPE Associate Degree in Business Studies and General Studies.

Added to its Self-Development Programs, is the Personal and Professional Development Course which focuses on the principles of leadership, customer service, effective communication and teamwork. This program will commence on Monday 19th September at 6.30pm.

Additionally, as Anguilla seeks to further establish itself globally, so to, must its people be able to communicate using different languages. Therefore, all are invited to take advantage of the new German Conversational Programme, or, the well established Conversational Spanish and French Programmes, which will commence on Monday 3rd October 2011.

As the Comprehensive Learning Centre continues to rise to the challenge of being responsive to the needs and realities of the nation, it launched its Online Registration System which is being fully accessed and utilised through its website www.clcaxa.org. Students, whose class attendance may sometimes be affected by shift work or any other interference entirely out of their control now have the opportunity to access online their missed classes, through a special code on the CLC's website. This new initiative provides all registered students with an equal opportunity for success.
