### **Small Service Project Update**

Four finished quilts were turned in at the July day meeting from the kits made from the large fabric donation. Pat McGough won the prize. More fabric kits are available to be signed out at the meetings. Eight more lap quilts were turned in by members so 12 lap quilts were delivered to Riverside Hospital on July 14th. That makes a total of 25 delivered for the year. Six quilts and 1 wall hanging were delivered to NATASHA House in July from quilts donated by members. More isolette covers, small quilts and fabric hearts will be delivered to Portsmouth Naval Hospital soon. Thank you for supporting Small Service Projects in the following ways:

- lap quilts approximately 32" x 38" for cancer patients,
