I started the FCA (Fellowship of Christian Athletes), and Southeast was the Interscholastic Football Champion in 1971. In 1971, the freshmen, JV, and varsity all were Interscholastic Football Champions. I had all games filmed and would review the previous game with the team on Monday. I also started "Dad's Night" so fathers could be honored along with their son.

In addition to FCA, I participated in Pep and Homecoming Assemblies.

Coach Jim Julian (math) and Clara Julian (Southeast Junior & Senior High School math and Athletic Director) were married. I was Jim's assistant in track and he was my assistant in football. Bill Herron was the principal. Jim Gurley coached freshmen football and taught physical education.

Beyond Southeast

My family lived in Sheraton Estates on Elmwood Avenue during my time at Southeast. I participated in summer FCA camps in Colorado and took the family for a one-week vacation (drove and saw the country). I also attended football camps in Missouri, Kansas, and Arkansas.

Current events during that time included the Vietnam War, Apollo 11 and man's walk on the moon and the voting age was lowered to 18.

I represented Southeast HS as a coach and did a commercial with Coach Hank Stram (KC Chiefs coach) for Milgram grocery store. I recently wrote a book that includes my years at Southeast. The book is entitled ***Myles Traveled***.
