## POLICE DEPARTMENT REPORT

All employees that were evaluated this year have been spoken to concerning their individual ratings. All evaluations were within the acceptable range. After discussing individual strengths and weaknesses each employee signed their evaluations without dissent.

Moving our Department files to a securer location is nearly complete, having taken longer than anticipated due to the volume of files needed to be relocated. It is anticipated that all files shall be locked in the secure location by the end of the fiscal year. In conjunction with the move we will be the installing cameras in the room to monitor all entry into the secure location.

Statistics from our Department for the month of May were: 49 citations issued, 51 FIC's written, 54 MIC's written, 4 arrests, and 144 calls for service, while 37% of aggregate time worked by the Officers were spent on patrolling our town.

It is now my honor to name the "Employee of the Month" for the Department. It is my honor to present this month's recipient of the award to Part Time Dispatcher Ida Lalonde. Ms. Lalonde has been working on moving our files to a more secure area in the Town Hall building. The completion of this task is slated for the end of this fiscal year.
