

Making the Head


<u>1.</u> Scrunch up at least 3 double sheets of newspaper tight in a ball, secure with tape.



2. Lay/wrap over a forth sheet of paper to create the neck



Tape , do not twist




3. Attach to bottle neck with 5 pieces of tape

Making the Arms

<u>1.</u> Take 1 double sheet of newspaper and scrunch into a sausage shape DO NOT FOLD!


<u>2.</u> Wrap tape tightly around making sure the shoulder end is wider than the hand.



3. Repeat this process making sure the next arm is the same size

4. Bend to create a shoulder shape

5. Tape on to bottle tightly



Making the Arms

<u>1.</u> Take 1 double sheet of newspaper and scrunch into a sausage shape DO NOT FOLD!


2. Wrap tape tightly around making sure the shoulder end is wider than the hand.



3. Repeat this process making sure the next arm is the same size


4. Bend to create a shoulder shape

5. Tape on to bottle tightly




Making the Head






Making the Dress

You must do this before you attach the arms

1. Tape on a double sheet of newspaper to the bottle about half way up. this must be loose at the bottom and not tight against the bottle



2. Turn the bottle upside down and stuff more newspaper in to it to make the dress fill out.



3. Fold the paper in to the bottom of the bottle and secure with tape
